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
Cornerstone Corner

October's Book for Kindergartners: *Join In and Play* by Cheri J. Meiners



This month our Kindergarten Project Cornerstone theme is friendship, which echoes last month's Project Cornerstone theme for 1st-5th graders. Making friends is one of the most important life skills, for children as well as adults! A 75-year longitudinal study by Harvard scholars revealed that among all the factors, having positive relationships correlates most with a person's health and well-being. Being kind, empathetic and inclusive is key to positive relationships.

Our Kindergarten ABC reader team will visit the classrooms and discuss with the kids about making friends and playing together. We will practice ways to join in, to get along when playing together, and to invite others to play. While we teach everybody to be inviting and inclusive, we also talk about what to do when people say no, and how to deal with conflicts during play. Finally, all Kindergartners will learn a rap song "Join in and Play" – We are the Kinders and this is what we say, "Everybody join in and play"!

In addition to her research she participates in the Santa Clara County "Keeping Youth Safe" coalition which has developed Tobacco Prevention toolkit which she will share with us.
