

Girls on the Run is a fun, life-changing, **after-school program** for 3rd-5th grade girls. The 10-week program **teaches girls life skills** such as confidence, healthy decision-making, and how to be a good friend- all while using a fun curriculum that creatively integrates **running**.

Girls leave the program saying "I am strong!", "I am amazing!", "I am beautiful, just the way I am!".

When is Girls on the Run? GOTR begins the week of March 6, 2017 and culminates in the end-of-season Girls on the Run 5K on Saturday, May 20th at Vasona Park. The Daves team will meet on Mondays and Wednesdays immediately after school on the Daves campus.

<u>HOW DO I REGISTER MY DAUGHTER?</u> This year Girls on the Run has moved to a lottery registration system. Registration is online only at www.gotrsv.org.

- Lottery Registration Period: Saturday, December 3-Monday, December 5, at 11:59 pm
- The computer-generated lottery will be run on Tuesday, December 6.
- Registration will reopen at 9:00 am on Wednesday, December 7, on a first-come, first-served basis at sites with spots available and for the waiting list at sites that filled.

"Fostering Resilience and Growth Mindset in your Child(ren)"

Speaker: Lisa DiMarino, M.A., LMFT is a Marriage and Family Therapist who has been working with adolescents and their families since 1996. She has a long history of educational collaboration with schools, supporting youth in a range of environments from expulsion schools to college prep. She spent nine years working with the Palo Alto School district, providing both direct student services and supervising behavior specialists. She founded the Pacific Wellness Center in 2006, and has been in private practice since then. In addition to working with adolescents and families in her practice, Lisa also conducts teacher trainings on how to work with teens and children who are struggling with their emotions. Lisa is currently seeing individual and families through her practice, consulting on a regular basis at Palo Alto Prep High School, and teaching "Counseling for Special Education Teachers" in the graduate school for education at Notre Dame de Namur University in Belmont.
