





Would school busing work for you? Tell us why or why not...

The Town of Los Gatos is exploring the feasibility of a local school bus service. The primary goal of the project is reducing traffic congestion near schools. This work is being conducted in coordination with, but independent from, the schools. The top considerations of the study include:

Traffic Congestion Relief - Each school bus can remove 36 vehicles from the road. Convenience - Neighborhood based pickup and drop-off balancing user fees with local transportation funds. Safety - Working to ensuring parents are comfortable with all aspects of the proposed service.

With the assistance from a consultant, the Town is conducting an online survey to evaluate interest levels from families. All Los Gatos Union School District and Los Gatos High School parents are invited to participate. The survey link was sent to all parents from the school districts in the week of January 15.

The survey is open until January 31. Everyone's opinion counts, whether you would be using the school bus service or not. If you have questions or need additional information, please contact the Town of Los Gatos at SchoolBus@losgatosca.gov.
