

#### Authors' Day books for K-2 all available at our library, with special thanks to the bookmobile for more copies!

Jim LaMarche speaks to our K-2nd grades on March 23. He's written and luminously illustrated many picture books. Biographical info is <u>here</u>. Guidance from Mrs. G re: ordering below. All of Jim's books are longer picture books. While the text is read-aloud for most K-2, the art speaks deeply to all ages (and young artists too).

Jim's most recent book, **Pond**, is one I wish every Daves family had at home. If everyone grew up with this vision of the world to quietly memorize, the world we help shape would be different. I am reading the book to every class, K-5, to remind students of their already certain power to influence our world, as a boy and his sister and best friend do locally here. One reviewer described it as "A loving portrayal of a never-forgotten connection with the natural world." Another as "...a truly marvelous offering about our influence on nature and its influence on us."

In *The Raft,* a child spends the summer with his grandmother. Early on, he'd rather be elsewhere. But that changes as he discovers the natural world around him at her home on the river, and he finds "an inner peace that looks as though it will last a lifetime."

**The Elves and the Shoemaker** was read to K-2 in December, as many classes attended the play. This is the classic story, with outstanding art. **A Story for Bear** speaks about the power of storytelling, and of friendship. **Lost and Found** and **Up** are both written and illustrated by Jim. The former was requested by several teachers, as it includes three separate dog stories. Neither is on our online order form, because they are not readily available from the publisher. If your children love them, and you can find copies, bring them! You can see them all at the Daves Library.


