Dear Parents,

I would like to thank our wonderful volunteers for the work on the amazing garden area that was created for our students on Earth Day. Members of the staff have already visited the area to take a walk with a few students who were missing their moms or those that were needing a break from the pace at lunch recess. It is wonderful to see how the garden can intrigue the students and take their minds off the things that are bothering them. We were notified last week that Daves also won a grant from Subaru to provide native plants to enhance the garden area. They will arrive this week. Again, our deepest gratitude goes to **Lisa Hanson** for her work with the Green Team and securing the awards and grants for Daves.

This week, our third through fifth grade students will begin the required State assessments. As a result of the testing schedule and the required time blocks for completion, it is vital that students arrive to school on time.
