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
Cornerstone Corner

This month's Project Cornerstone book, <u>The OK Book</u>, by Amy Krouse Rosenthal, focuses on resilience and enjoying the process of trying new things. By using the building blocks of resiliency as a cornerstone, youth will be better prepared to overcome the challenges of new and difficult experiences.

Conversation Starter: What is a new thing you have tried lately? What happened? Were you successful the first time? When something felt difficult, what helped you stick with it and keep trying? Is it OK with you to be just OK at something fun to do?

Tips: Discuss how your child can choose how he or she reacts to new challenges. Tell him or her "you can *use your lid*" to control your reactions."

Help your child 'dare to try' new things that *spark* them such as something interesting to them, something challenging, or a new adventure.
