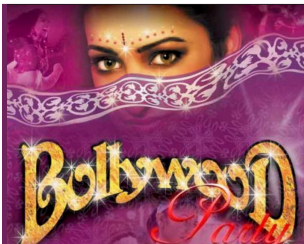
CARNIVAL CHAIR
