PRINCIPAL'S MESSAGE

Dear Parents:

I have been asked by staff and parents to get this information out to you this week to avoid any confusion as to how children are placed in classrooms for the upcoming school year. Many times, parents and teachers use the Spring Conference to talk about a child's progression into the next grade level.

Our staff will make plans for classroom assignments for the 2017-18 school year in June. Your child's current teacher will make balanced class assignments. We feel the teachers are in the best position to make this decision. Teachers have worked with your child throughout the year and have the best "handle" on each child's strengths and opportunities for growth.

The staff considers a number of variables when classroom groups are prepared. Areas taken into consideration are: range of academic abilities; numbers of boys and girls; leadership skills-academic, social, and athletic; individual learning styles; behavior, special education needs; students benefiting from being together or separated; student personality and interaction; and class size. The objective of the process is to produce the most "workable" heterogeneous combination of student groups. This important task contributes significantly to the creation of a positive class environment that enables students to reach their potential. Staff members are assigned to these classes during the summer based upon the best possible "match" of teaching skills and student needs, number of class sections needed at each grade level, and staff preferences for grade level assignments. Teaching assignments may change over the summer as enrollment shifts and personnel changes occur.

Parents may want to share information about their child's learning style to help us in the placement process. This should be put in writing with the reasons outlined and related to the educational areas mentioned above. Requests for specific teachers are not appropriate and will not be considered when student placement is made.

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Principal's Message continued...

In the past, parents have expressed concern that there is an "underground system" at work in which a parent makes a special classroom request through their child's teacher or the principal. This places the both in a very uncomfortable position, if parents make a request--they may feel their request was honored or denied--depending on the class placement, when in fact the name request was not used in any way when the child's placement was made. Individual requests may actually backfire for a child if a request is honored that skews the balance particularly in the area of social and emotional needs of a class. Honoring even just a few requests leaves other parents, who follow protocol, with the feeling that the system is unfair.

The Daves Avenue staff takes classroom placement of all children very seriously and wants only the best for your child. Our goal is to provide fair and equitable treatment for all children as a means to encourage and support their learning. Please rely on our professional judgment, and trust that we will group children to provide the best possible learning environment. Students and parents will be informed of class assignments in late August prior to the opening of school. When placements are announced, your cooperation and support of this process provides the best possible outcome for students and staff.

Daves partners with OhmConnect to get cash for Daves by having our school families conserve electricity at home during high-use energy times, with alerts called "Ohm Hours". You simply load your smart devices into their system OR manually turn them off for 1 hour when alerted - they tell you a day ahead of time when the Ohm Hour will be. We raised nearly \$1,000 this year from 12 families, and now we are up to 22 families - if you register then we will possibly generate thousands of dollars over the summer (by turning off your AC or car charger or pool pump for 1 little tiny hour).

It is super easy. You don't need to do all of them, there are 2-4 per week it seems. You'll need your online user ID for PG&E when you register. OhmConnect can only see the activity on the smart meter on your home, it cannot see your banking information or other personal details.
