The Second Harvest Food Bank drive will continue at all schools **through December 18, 2013**. Last year the LHUSD collected close to 4,000 pounds of food. Please donate to this worthy cause!

Did you know:

- 1 in 10 people in Santa Clara County will receive food from the food bank this year
- 250-275 pounds of food feed 100 people 3 times a day for one week



• 295 pounds of food feed a dozen children 4 times a day for one week

Recommendations from the food bank for nutritious, non-perishable, foods for children and families include: pop top tuna, raisins, unsweetened applesauce, fruit juice boxes, meals in a can, canned fruit and vegetables, peanut butter.



SIMPLICITY PARENTING BOOK GROUP

In these busy times many of our lives are characterized by randomness and improvisation such as last minute business trips, irregular bedtimes and meals, event hopping, and over scheduled weekends. In our last meeting we discussed many simple ways to introduce small bits of rhythm that children can count upon, providing regular bass notes in the melody of life. "Rhythm calms and secures children, grounding them in the earth of family so they can branch out and grow." The author continues, "For

parents, the advantages of rhythm are equally pronounced. Rhythm carves the necessary channels for discipline, making it more intrinsic than imposed. Where well-established rhythms exist, there is much less parental verbiage, less effort, and fewer problems around transitions." Think about your days and problem spots to see what small things you can introduce, be it watering the plants before school, a story before bedtime, weekly meals, winter walks, or just flipping through magazines over snack after school.
