

Why Is LGUSD The Envy Of Other Public School Districts?

The excellence of the programs and resources offered in the Los Gatos Union School District (LGUSD) is supported through parent and local community generosity, in the form of donations to our Home and School Clubs and to the Los Gatos Education Foundation (Foundation).

The State and Federal governments provides almost no funding to the five public schools in LGUSD (Blossom Hill Elementary, Daves Avenue Elementary, Lexington Elementary, Louise Van Meter Elementary and R.J. Fisher Middle School). In 2011-12, California ranked 47th overall in how much it spends per student – \$8,667 when adjusted for regional cost differences, about \$3,000 below the national average of \$11,665 (source: Quality Counts 2012).

As a consequence, LGUSD relies heavily on a **blended funding model** that includes annual property taxes, parcel tax, and donations through the Foundation and the Home & School Clubs.

Funds raised by the Los Gatos Education Foundation directly benefit every student at all five schools (Blossom Hill Elementary, Daves Avenue Elementary, Lexington Elementary, Louise Van Meter Elementary and R.J. Fisher Middle School), providing equitable programs in the areas of Science, Music, Art, Resources, and Technology.

Funds raised by your Home & School Club benefit your child at his/her school and supplement district-wide funded programs in the areas of literacy, technology, physical education, mathematics, science, health, safety, student supplies, and other activities specific to each school site.

It is important that we as parents support both the Home & School Clubs and the Foundation in whatever capacity we can, in order to maintain current programs and resources for our children, and to keep our schools and our children thriving.
