

Cornerstone Corner

May Book for Kindergartners: "Try and Stick With It" by Cheri J. Meiners





Learning has a curve, the path to pursue your dream has ups and downs, and the magic power to guide you along, is perseverance! This month, we will lead the kids to really understand its power. We'll start by asking them "What things are easy for you?" After they get all excited, ask "Were they ever hard?" Let them recall, think and share why they have become easier now. Going through this process using their own experience helps understand the importance of trying and persevering. In the future, when they learn something new, or encounter difficulties, remind them the lesson that they shared, and tell them "you know the magic"!

Perseverance is a combination of assertiveness, courage, patience, determination and persistence. Children with a can-do attitude learn that with perseverance they can accomplish and learn new things. Belief in the ability to change and grow is

called a growth mindset. A growth mindset allows a person to view challenges as something new to learn. Having persistence will enable a young person to apply skills they have to new and difficult experiences. It also focuses on giving new things a try, enjoying the experience of trying and dealing with mastery over harder things to do.

The Sesame Street song "Don't Give Up" by Bruno Mars is a nice song about persevering. The MV is fun to watch, with Telly and Grover showing examples of trying and trying again. There are also many books on perseverance, e.g., "The Little Engine that Could" (for younger kids), "Sebastian's Roller Skates", "Salt in His Shoes", to name a few.
