# PRINCIPAL'S MESSAGE

Dear Daves Avenue Families:

Thank you to the staff and students for a pretty amazing 1<sup>st</sup> full week of school! Routines are being established and learning is definitely taking place. The more familiar I become with Daves Avenue, the more impressed I am with our school focus on student learning and the whole child.

It was so nice to get an opportunity to meet with parents at Back to School Night and talk about students. The common refrain from the evening was how excited children are to be back at school and how happy parents and students both are to be at Daves!

Please remember traffic safety protocols on campus. Traffic coming from Daves Avenue south onto Poppy Drive must enter into the Daves Avenue lot in front of the school. Traffic heading north on Poppy Drive must enter into the side drop off loop facing Poppy Drive. Please take care to drive slowly, set down phones, and stay with your car. Should you wish to walk in for drop-off or pick-up, please use our school parking lots or the Oak Tree overflow parking area. Parents and students alike must use our crosswalks. Remember this is for everyone's safety!

Next, in order to ensure that instructional time is not disrupted: 1) Please arrange and discuss any after school plans with your child before sending them off each morning. It is very difficult to locate and interrupt teaching in the classroom for messages. 2) Call the attendance line (24 hours a day) if your child will be late or out of school. This line must be called even if you email or let the teacher know. We have a safe call procedure and all your numbers will be called to notify you that your student is not here. 3) Please try to send your child to school with his/her lunch or snack everyday. It is very difficult to have to locate and have that child leave their lesson time for retrieval of the lunch or snack. 4) Please be prompt when picking up your child after school. Please sign up for after-school care and have your child aware that they should go to that safe place when you cannot make it on time. Pick up should never be later than 2:45 on a regular schedule day, or 12:45 on a minimum day unless there is an emergency. 5) If you need to check out a student early try to let the teacher know by e-mail 24 hours in advance if possible. Then, come to the office allowing enough time for us to locate and have your student come down. Please do not call the office and ask for this to be done ahead of time. We will do this at the time you arrive as to not have the student spend more time out of the classroom than necessary.

Thank you for your consideration and ensuring the safety and the instruction of all students is first!



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
