#### WELCOME BACK TO PE!

We have had a great start to our 2013/2014 Physical Education (PE) year! I'm so looking forward to experiencing Mileage Club (with a twist), Personal Best, The Great British Egg and Spoon Race, Nutrition and Health discussions and more with your children this year. The hot weather we had this week will likely continue into late September, so **please supply your child with a water bottle** and I will do my best to train them to bring it with them to PE! On very hot days I also have a rose spray with cool water which they love!

Elementary age children are starting sports earlier than ever before; some sports are even all year round which can result in overuse of muscle groups and joints. Changing up sport choices or 'cross training' can help prevent injury. At this age the children's' bones are still growing and the ends (growth plates) are susceptible to trauma along with the usual joint sprains and strains.

Please teach your child to remember to set out appropriate footwear the night before their PE day. Uggs, knee high boots, sandals, Crocs, Tevas, etc. are not safe footwear and provide no ankle support. Below is your child's PE day so they can plan ahead! 5th graders have PE first thing Friday mornings, so please remind them (as I will) to eat a healthy breakfast as they will be going to class having used up their stored energy!


