



Cornerstone Corner

March Book for Kindergartners: "Be Polite and Kind" by Cheri J. Meiners



This month our Kindergarten Project Cornerstone topic is kindness and manners. "Manners are a sensitive awareness of the feeling of others. If you have that awareness, you have good manners, no matter what fork you use" - Emily Post

At their core, manners are simply about caring for others. Manners provide valuable lessons in consideration, gratitude, and respect. The best way to teach politeness and kindness is to role model the behaviors you want children to do. How often to you use magic manner words or do acts of caring for others? As you use a magic manner word or do an act of kindness, verbalize this so that children are made aware of what you have said or done. Say, "I am using my magic manner word." Or "I want to be kind, or this is an act of kindness." The "Say Hey Day" initiative at Daves is a great start to reinforce the act of kindness. It shows how easy it is to show kindness and spread kindness, and yet it is powerful to brighten others' day and have a positive impact on our community.

"May I please have a cookie" is another fun book about manners for kindergartners, and while reading the book we use the "thumbs up" technique - they need to pay attention to the magic manner words and give a thumbs up whenever they hear one.



H&SC Positions Descriptions

Green Team Co-Chair - The Green Team is a group of students who take a leadership role in identifying and implementing solutions to make Daves a "greener" school. They encourage awareness in students regarding choices they make and how they may impact the environment. You will help lead the kids in this program. In addition, you will assist with planning events, projects, and/or activities that will encourage awareness in regard to Earth Day/Week.

Cool Cat Auction Chair - Our annual spring fundraiser for adults only. Starting in late fall with a kick-off meeting, it will really ramp up right after the holiday break. With a solid team of volunteers (and this one usually isn't hard to recruit for), you can make this fundraiser a huge success! This involves all aspects of a big event - marketing, auction solicitation and management, volunteer recruitment, venue procurement, food selection, decorating...Lots of time involved on this one - but a very fun event to plan!

Champions of Math Co-Chair - This program is designed to stimulate enthusiasm for mathematics by teaching different problem-solving skills and using a creative approach to finding solutions. The chairs are responsible for all aspects of the class which include preparing the materials for each week's class introducing a new problem solving skill, teaching the class, administering monthly tests, updating the website, and communicating with parents. The classes meet weekly after school; the class begins in the Fall and runs until the Spring.

FREE2ME Co-Chair - This position promotes and works with a variety of companies and programs (including eScrip and AmazonSmile) to help raise money for Daves. This is a flexible, important position that can be done on your own time. If you want to help raise FREE money for Daves, this is the job for you.

Memory Book Co-Chair - This chair is in charge of our school yearbook! You will plan, design, and implement our hardbound, full-color yearbook. You will work with parents and teachers to take the book from concept to reality. This creative job involves attending meetings, working with the on-line memory book program, taking photos, designing the cover pages and helping the memory book class representatives produce their pages as needed.

CASA Co-Chair - As a representative of CASA for the elementary school level, you will help promote healthy lifestyle choices. The big event is Red Ribbon Week in October. This includes coordinating with Student Council to get the word out at the Wednesday Wave, the newsletter, and in the classrooms. The CASA Chair should attend CASA meetings and understand the importance of making healthy, important choices.
