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

CORNERSTONE CORNER


This month's Project Cornerstone book, <u>Rene Has</u> <u>Two Last Names</u>, promotes positive cultural identity and understanding of others. This book gives students practical ways to build empathy and tolerance, and to use positive personal power to stand up for traditions and beliefs.

Conversation Starter: Has anyone ever made fun of you because you were different? How did that make you feel? What advice would you give another student who was feeling this way? Have you ever helped a student feel more comfortable? What did you do?

Tips: Discuss how students can put a lid on their buckets if they are being teased and how they can be upstanders for others. Share or explore the origins of your child's first and last names with your child.

By teaching our children the importance of accepting others and sharing our cultural heritage, we create a stronger community where all students feel safe and know that they belong.
