PRINCIPAL'S MESSAGE

Dear Daves Avenue Families,

This week I wanted to highlight some of the amazing things our students are involved with both inside and outside of the classroom.

As a part of a service-learning project during the holiday season, our third graders worked together to collect supplies for 150 hygiene kits. These kits included items like soap, shampoo, conditioner, Kleenex, socks, toothbrushes, toothpaste, etc. Then they assembled them as a whole grade level and wrote notes of kindness for each kit. These kits were then distributed to homeless people in San Jose through an organization called Downtown Streets Team. Teachers and students talked about how compassion really is "empathy in action." On the next page are a couple of pictures of our students at work.

As one of many after-school activities, a group of eight students, six from Daves Ave and two from Fisher, participated in the 2017 First Lego League competition. FLL is a well-known robotics program for children ages 9-14. Each year more than 250,000 kids in 85 countries apply science, engineering and math concepts to develop solutions to real-world problems, along the way, they also learn valuable employment and life skills.

This year's competition theme was Hydro Dynamics exploring the location, use, storage and movement of water. The boys called themselves "Savage Cabbages".

They met every Sunday since the beginning of the school year to build and program a robot able to navigate, pick up and move items, even flush a LEGO toilet. Additionally, they worked on a presentation on how residents can reduce wasteful water usage. The team presented their project to former Los Gatos Mayor Marico Sayoc at Town Hall on Nov. 1. They then competed in the FLL Nor Cal region qualifier tournament on Nov. 12, held at Cupertino High School. The team was coached by two fathers and one grandfather of the students.

As we move forward, I look forward to showcasing more of the wonderful things our teachers and students are doing here at Daves!

Town of Los Gatos School Bus Service Feasibility Study

The Town of Los Gatos is exploring the feasibility of a local school bus service that is independent of the schools with the primary goal of reducing traffic congestion near schools. The primary consideration of the study include:

- Traffic Congestion Relief – each school bus can remove 36 vehicles from the road.
- Convenience – Neighborhood based pickup and drop-off balancing user fees with local transportation funds.
- Safety – working to ensuring parents are comfortable with all aspects of the proposed service.
